NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- **January 1, 2009 Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3:** Jump Heights required with entry. Include Jump Height on entry form with class. Entries without Jump Height will be judged at the end of the class.
- **Jump Heights** will be in Ascending Order
- **Qualifying Score** Required for All Ribbons/Rosettes
- **No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted** which specifies any condition as to acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" that accompanies the Official AKC entry form.
- **This club does not agree** to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- **Changes, additions, or corrections** to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Changes received by telephone are not accepted.
- **Entries received** without fees will not be accepted.
- **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Entries accompanied by returned checks will be charged an additional \$30 fee.
- **There is no refund for duplicate entries or overpayments.** The Match Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- **Entry fee shall not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Match Committee. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season.
- **No entry fee will be refunded** if the match cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians'** recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **Dogs may arrive at any time** prior to their scheduled time for judging, but not before opening Match hour of 4:00 P.M. After being judged, dogs not required for further judging may be excused.
- **Judges need not wait** for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- **Exhibitors are responsible to pick up** after their dog---no exceptions!
- **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Match Committee, be asked to leave the match site. In such case, no refund of any entry fee shall be made.
- **All dogs must be on leash** at all times except when in the ring for judging.
- **Dogs are allowed** in rings during judging only.
- **There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training** of dogs on the match grounds.
- **The Border Collie Club of Arizona and MLF Dog Sports,** officers and members, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs, property, or children.
- **Ribbons will be awarded** in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog. No awards will be mailed.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies. I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteer of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired). Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days, from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner to any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
